

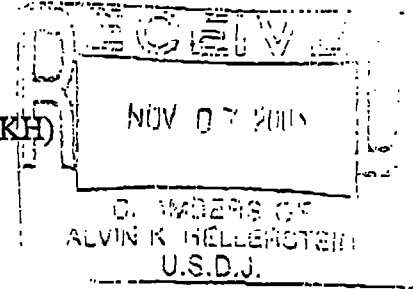

ALVIN K. HELLERSTEIN, U.S.D.J.:

WHEREAS the Court having heard argument at a hearing on October 28, 2003, concerning a Motley Rice October 22, 2003 written request to restructure the Plaintiffs' Executive Committee in light of Mary Schiavo's, Esq. withdrawal from the firm of Baum Hedland Aristei & Guilford ("Baum Hedland") and joining the firm of Motley Rice and having also considered a letter dated October 23, 2003 by Gerald S. Crowley, Esq. on behalf of the Port Authority, a letter dated October 27, 2003 by Marc Moller, Esq. on behalf of the Plaintiffs' Executive Committee, and a letter dated October 27, 2003 by Michael Baum, Esq. on behalf of the Baum Hedland firm.


Whereas by Order dated October 7, 2002, this Court approved the PEC and its subcommittee structure.

Whereas by Stipulation and Order dated February 19, 2003, this Court ordered that Motley Rice (then "Ness Motley") was precluded from serving on the Plaintiffs' Executive Committee (PEC) and its subcommittees.

NOW IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT Motley Rice's request to modify the February 19, 2003 Stipulation and Order is denied and the structure of the PEC and its subcommittees will continue as set forth in this Court's October 7, 2002 Order;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT Mary Schiavo, Esq. shall no longer serve as a member of the Plaintiffs' Executive Committee or any of its subcommittees.
