The parties appeared before me on June 8, 2006 on an order to show cause why the list of attorneys seeking to attend the depositions and receive clearance should not be radically limited. Having issued an order at the hearing as to the number of attorneys, and their representations, who may seek clearance and thus attend the depositions, and having reconsidered the need for representation at the depositions by each of the three security companies involved at the relevant airports on September 11, 2001, it is hereby:

ORDERED that each security company be permitted to seek clearance for one attorney, for a total of three attorneys, and that such cleared attorneys be allowed to attend all depositions.
